Component 6: I can take part in a re-enactment of Holi Festival.

What we will know after this sequence:

- How and why Holi is celebrated.
- Different traditions that Hindus take part in.

Vocabulary: Holi, festival, Krishna, Holika, Prahlad, sing, dance, milkmaids.

SEN: Awareness of noise levels and other sensory problems that might occur.



Component 4: I can retell the story of Lord Ganesha

What we will know after this sequence:

- How Lord Ganesha got his elephant head.
- What Ganesha represents.
- Why Ganesha is celebrated.

Vocabulary: Ganesha, elephant, sculpture, Shiva, Parvati, blessings.

How will this feed into my next learning:

I can name and describe some special Hindu festivals.

SEN: Story board ready-made, sentence stems to finish.



Component 5: I can name and describe some special Hindu festivals.

What we will know after this sequence:

- I can name and describe the main Hindu festivals.
- I can explain how some festivals are celebrated.

Vocabulary: Diwali, Holi, Navaratri, celebrations, festivals, Rama, Sita, Ravana, Hanuman, good, evil, Diva, diva lamps, Durga, Lakshmi, Krishna, stories, dancing.

How will this feed into my next learning:

- I can take part in a re-enactment of Holi Festival.

SEN: Festival fact sheets, key words, pictures for each key word.



Component 3: I can retell the story of Rama and Sita

What we will know after this sequence:

- The story of Rama and Sita
- How Diwali is celebrated today.

Vocabulary: Warrior, Rama, Sita, banished, demon, Ravana, chariot, Hanuman, Diwali

How will this feed into my next learning:

- I can retell the story of Lord Ganesha

SEN: Story board ready-made, sentence stems to finish.



Component 2: I can explain which places are special to Hindus

What we will know after this sequence:

- I can identify where Hindus worship.
- I can explain the similarities and differences between worshipping at a mandir and at home.

Vocabulary: Hinduism, Hindu, mandir, statues, worship, beliefs, bell, offerings, pandit, priest, murti, aarti, flame, aarti plate, central hall, shoes, Aum, Vedas.

How will this feed into my next learning:

- I can retell the story of Rama and Sita

SEN: Labelled diagrams provided, key vocabulary explanations.



Component 1: I can explain the main beliefs in Hinduism.

We should know:

- That Christianity is not the only religion.
- That people have the right to choose their own beliefs.

What we will know after this sequence:

- That Hindus follow many Gods
- The names and roles of different deities

Vocabulary: Hindu, gods, goddesses, Brahma, Monotheism, Polytheism, Vishnu, Shiva, Sarawati, Lakshmi, Shakti, Parvati, deities

How will this feed into my next learning:

- I can explain which places are special to Hindus

SEN: Labelled diagrams of the Gods, vocabulary mats.
