<p>Challenge 1</p> <p>History – Victorian Toys</p> <p>Can you design or make your own Victorian toy? Remember in the past they would have used resources or materials found around the home to make toys and games.</p> <p>You might make a spinning top or a kite!</p> 	<p>Challenge 2</p> <p>Computing – Lego Builders</p> <p>This term Shark class are looking at algorithms and writing instructions. Can you create a simple Lego person or animal and write instructions to make it?</p> <p>Remember to make your instructions as clear as possible!</p> 
<p>Challenge 3</p> <p>PSHE – Christmas around the World</p> <p>Can you create a poster showing how you or others celebrate Christmas in your household? You might draw some pictures or write a story about what you do on the day!</p> 	<p>Challenge 4</p> <p>PE – Dance</p> <p>This term Shark Class are working on a dance about toys – what is your favourite toy character?</p> <p>Can you create a few moves that might link with your character? For example, if you have Woody from Toy Story you might march like a cowboy or pretend to catch a horse.</p> 
<p>Challenge 5</p> <p>Science – Seasons</p> <p>Can you create a piece of artwork on Autumn using natural resources found in your garden or local area? You might find some fallen leaves or conkers!</p> 	<p>Challenge 6</p> <p>Music – Seasons</p> <p>Can you go for a walk in your local area and identify the different sounds during this season?</p> <p>What do the leaves sound like as you walk through them? Is it windy? What does that sound like?</p>
