Component 4: Participate in team games using attacking and defending tactics.

What we will know after this sequence:

- How to work as a team
- How to communicate when playing hockey.

Vocabulary:

Communication, teamwork, pass, accuracy, dribble, goal.

How will this feed into my next learning:

I will play a tournament to practice my skills.

SEN: Plastic hockey stick, larger ball, more space, support with group work.



Component 5: I will learn how to defend in a game of hockey.

What we will know after this sequence:

- How we can use defence tactics to stop a team scoring.

Vocabulary:

Defence, tackle, tactics, team work.

How will this feed into my next learning:

- I can begin to play small sided games

SEN: Plastic hockey stick, larger ball, more space, support with group work.



Component 3: I will learn how to pass a hockey ball.

What we will know after this sequence:

- How to pass accurately.
- How to stop a hockey ball.

Vocabulary:

Accuracy, pass, speed, direction

How will this feed into my next learning:

I will learn how to defend in a game of hockey.

SEN: Plastic hockey stick, larger ball, less space, support with group work.



Component 2: Hockey skills – dribbling and stopping.

What we will know after this sequence:

- How to travel with speed when dribbling a hockey ball.
- How to change direction when dribbling.

Vocabulary:

Dribbling, speed, change, control.

How will this feed into my next learning:

I will learn how to pass a hockey ball.

SEN: Plastic hockey stick, larger ball, less space, support with group work.



Component 1: Hockey awareness – basic movements, coordination.

We should know:

- That hockey is a sport played with a ball and a stick.

What we will know after this sequence:

- How to hold a hockey stick correctly
- Safety when holding a hockey stick
- How to dribble a hockey ball
- How to stop a hockey ball

Vocabulary:

Stick, ball, stop, dribble, control.

How will this feed into my next learning:

I will build on my knowledge of dribbling and stopping a hockey ball.

SEN: Plastic hockey stick, larger ball, less space, support with group work.
