<p><b>Challenge 1</b></p> <p><b>Science- Growing Up</b></p> <p>Can you find any old baby photos of yourself and took through what you could/could not do at that age with a parent/adult?</p> <p>Why do babies need lots of support?</p> 	<p><b>Challenge 2</b></p> <p><b>History – Charles Dickens</b></p> <p>Can you create a sketch of Charles Dickens and then with support write down any key facts about his life or where he lived?</p> <p>There are some buildings very close to us that were very important in his life!</p> 
<p><b>Challenge 3</b></p> <p><b>PSHE – disagreements</b></p> <p>Can you draw a picture that gives an example of when a disagreement/falling out has occurred?</p>  <p>For example, it might be a disagreement between you and your sibling over the TV remote or who should play with a certain toy.</p> <p>How do you think they could solve the disagreement?</p>	<p><b>Challenge 4</b></p> <p><b>Music – traditions and melodies</b></p> <p>Talk with your family and close friends and ask them what songs and music are important to them. Ask to listen to them and give your opinion – do you like it? What is it you like about the music/melody? Which instruments can you hear?</p> 
<p><b>Challenge 5</b></p> <p><b>Computing – Pictograms</b></p> <p>Can you create a pictogram to represent how many pairs of shoes each of your family members has?</p> <p>Remember to draw a picture to represent a number. i.e. If you have 10 pairs of shoes, you might draw 10 shoes, or 5 if each shoe represent 2 pairs!</p>	<p><b>Challenge 6</b></p> <p><b>PSHE – Laws and rules</b></p> <p>If you could pass any new law in England what would it be and why?
