







Year 3 Home-Learning Term 2

Can you recall any key facts from her life?</p> 	<p>Challenge 4</p> <p>RE – Judaism</p> <p>To research and describe key objects found in a synagogue and describe what they are used for and why they are important to Jewish people.</p>
