What we will know after this sequence:

LQ: Can I explain the Christian symbols?

Children will know what the Christian symbols are.

Children will understand that some symbols belong to religions.

Children will be able to explain what a symbol is.

Children will be able to discuss the meaning behind different religious symbols.

Vocabulary:

Religious, religion, symbols, Christian, cross, fish, flame, church

How will this feed into my next learning:

Children will recognise the importance of Christian beliefs.

What we will know after this sequence:

LQ: Can I explain what the bible is?

Children will know what the bible is.

Children will know that is inside the Bible.

Children will know why the Bible is special to Christians.

Children will understand how the Bible is organised.

Vocabulary:


Bible, commandments, rules, book, important

What we will know after this sequence:

Component 2:

What we will know after this sequence:

LQ: Can I discuss the key parts of a church?

Children will be able to talk about some important things that Christians believe.

Children will be able to name and talk about some important parts of a Christian church.

Children will be able to place objects within a church plan and know why the shape of a church is important.

Children will be able to think about what happens in a church.

Vocabulary:

Church, Christian, believe, belief, pray, prayer, worship, altar, lectern, font

How will this feed into my next learning:

Children will apply their understanding to the story of the good Samaritan.

SEN:

Component 1:

We should know:

Some stories from the bible, some buildings that are considered a place of worship.

What we will know after this sequence:

LQ: Can I find out about Christian beliefs?

Children will know that Christian people believe in one God and that his son is Jesus Christ.

Children will know that Christians believe that God created the world.

Children will know that Christmas is a Christian celebration of the birth of Jesus.

Children will know that Easter is a Christian celebration to remember Jesus coming back to life three days after he died on the cross.

Children will know that Christians pray to God.

Children will know that Christians follow God's rules in the holy book the Bible.
